

Gold Pool Opening Service

Pool Opening

Remove Safety cover or tarp
Remove winter fitting and install summer fittings
Install Paramount six-port Module, if needed
Install ladder, step rails, and basketball goal, as needed
Start system and evaluate operation
Complete Equipment Checklist

Pool Cleaning

POOL OPENING SERVICE INCLUDES: ■ Replace O-rings, gauges, and/or gasket, as needed ■ Vacuum dirt and debris, up to one hour ■ Brush pool walls and scrub water line ■ Net surface of pool water ■ Shock and algaecide are included

Pump

Check for Proper operation/flow/circulation and adjust, if needed
Check impeller and clean out debris, if needed
Check all seals and replace, if needed

Ball Valves

Check for and notify if replacement is needed

Filter

Change sand/Clean Cartridge Filter
Check all Seals and replace, if needed
Check Mult-port operation
Check internal filter parts

Chlorinator/Salt Cell

Check Operations and adjust, if needed
Check and replace seals, if needed
Clean salt cell
Clean chlorinator strainer, if needed

Heater

Check for proper operation and adjust, if needed
Clean all debris from burners and heat exchangers
Check for proper gas pressure
Check for soot on heat exchanger and clean
Check for any or all leaks and fix, if needed

UV/O3

Check operation
Check all seals and replace

Auto cover

Clean debris out of auto cover box
Cleaning of cover tracks
Inspection and tightening of all hardware
Evaluation of pulleys, sensors, sliders/gliders, and guides
Replace of sliders/gliders, guides, and pulleys, if necessary
Alignment and safety inspection of fabric and ropes
Clean cover as needed, up to one hour

Check for Settling of the Equipment Pad

If settling has occurred, check plumbing for excessive stress that may cause future issues and notify customer

Pool Closing

Winterize pump, salt cell, chlorinator, Ozonator, UV, heater, filter, as needed
Winterize in-floor cleaning system, where applicable
Winterize skimmer
Winterize Returns
Install tarp/safety cover
